

THE FLAGS - AND WHAT THEY MEAN!

You will see several flagmen standing around the race course the entire weekend, usually situated at the corners and one man standing at the Start/Finish line. They will be waving their flags all weekend - so what does it all mean, what are they saying?

Here is a quick rundown of the Flag colours and what they stand for:

1. **GREEN FLAG** - When this one drops at the start - **RIDE IT LIKE YOU STOLE IT!**
2. **YELLOW FLAG** - This is a **CAUTION** - somebody up ahead has lost their sled and doesn't know where to find it! There is no passing in the Yellow Flag Zone.
3. **RED FLAG** - This means the **RACE IS STOPPED** - the track is blocked up ahead or somebody has fallen and they can't get up.
4. **BLUE FLAG** - Get ready for a forced pass - this is waved at the slow guys, get outta the way the race leaders are coming up fast behind you. This keeps the race tempo up.
5. **BLACK FLAG** - Signals a warning, disqualification or penalty due to a rule violation.
6. **WHITE FLAG** - **ONE LAP LEFT** - time for tha' skills!
7. **CHECKERED FLAG** - The race is over **BUT NOT THE WEEKEND!** Time to try a funky trick over the finish line - **I DARE YA!**
