Hedley & Blue Rodeo Tickets go on sale this Thursday

Tickets for the highly anticipated Kirkland Lake Homecoming concerts go on sale to the public this Thursday night at 6 o'clock at the complex. The Festivals Committee has released additional details of the ticket sales launch.

There will be a maximum of 6 tickets for each show per person and all sales are cash only at the complex. Several ticket tables will be set up at the back of the arena. The lineup for tickets will be in the back parking lot area of the complex.

Organizers will be on hand issuing numbered tickets to people as they arrive to solidify their place in line. Based on previous Homecoming ticket sales and the popularity of this year's bands, a large crowd is expected for Thursday night's sales launch.

Online tickets go on sale at 10 am on Friday at klfestivals.com. A limited number of packages are being reserved for online sales to ensure

Homecoming visitors wanting to see both bands have the opportunity to get tickets.

The 3 nights of concerts for the award-winning festival will feature back-to-back concerts by Hedley on Thursday, June 27 and Friday, June 28. Blue Rodeo will headline the final concert on Saturday, June 29.

Hedley will be joined by opening acts Suzie McNeil and Eleven Past One for both Kirkland Lake shows. Blue Rodeo will be supported by former Moist frontman, David Usher and Devin Cuddy, the son of Blue Rodeo star Jim Cuddy.

Tickets are \$60 for Hedley and \$50 for Blue Rodeo. A limited number of Homecoming packages will be available for \$100 and include a ticket to Blue Rodeo and one of the Hedley concerts.

The three concerts are for all ages, but the back portion of the floor of the arena will be licensed for ages 19 years and over for both Hedley shows and the entire floor will be licensed for the Blue Rodeo concert.

Kirkland Lake Homecoming Week runs from June 25-July 1. The Kirkland Lake Festivals Committee will announce a complete schedule of events in April.
