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**RELEASE OF LIABILITY
& ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT**

For the Kirkland Lake Festivals Committee 3 on 3 Tournament

I, _____, the parent or legal guardian (the “Undersigned”) of the mentioned minor participant, _____ (the “Participant”), hereby grant permission to the Participant to participate in the KL Festivals Committee 3 on 3 Tournament and I agree myself and on behalf of the Participant, to the following terms, conditions, and requirements:

1. The Undersigned and/or Participant understand, acknowledge, and agree that this agreement applies whether the Participant is an observer, a bystander, or an active participant.
2. I understand that at all times the Participant must obey and show respect for all the KL Festivals Volunteers.
3. I understand that I am financially liable for property damage caused by the Participant.
4. I understand that hockey is dangerous and can result in injury, death or personal property damage, and I am fully aware of the risks and hazards inherent to such activities and hereby sign up voluntarily.
5. The Participant and I understand that **equipment is mandatory** during the 3 on 3 Tournament and will be worn properly while participating.
6. I waive all claims and release the KL Festivals Committee, the Town of Kirkland Lake, and Northern College against any and all liability in respect to any loss or damage to my property or my person, or the Participant’s property or person, including any such loss or damage that is caused or contributed to by the negligence of any of the above.
7. I waive all claims and release KL Festivals Committee, the Town of Kirkland Lake, and Northern College from and against any and all liability in respect to personal injury or death to the Participant, except where such loss or damage is caused or contributed to by the KL Festivals Committee, the Town of Kirkland Lake, or Northern College negligence or by such other act or omission for which KL Festivals Committee, the Town of Kirkland Lake, or Northern College is legally responsible, and the case of such negligence or other act of omission.
8. KL Festivals Volunteers have my permission to revoke participation privileges to the Participant due to any violation of the fore mentioned rules.
9. I warrant to KL Festivals Committee, the Town of Kirkland Lake, and Northern College that the information on this Form (as well as the REGISTRATION FORM) is true, current and accurate and that I have read and understood all of its content.
10. If any clause in this document is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining clauses continue in effect.

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Rules and Regulations

A. General Rules

- This tournament stresses good sportsmanship and lots of fun.
- Anyone who is assessed a major penalty or misconduct penalty, including abuse of officials may be expelled.
- The tournament will have three divisions: **birth years 1999-2001, 2002-2004, 2005-2007**
- All teams may have a minimum of 4 participants and a maximum of 10 participants
- Players may play for only 1 (one) registered team in their own age level or “up”
- goalies may play for as many teams as they like and may play in their own level or may play “up”
- The Festivals Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all entries.
- A Waiver and Release of Liability Form must be signed by all participants and guardian

B. General Game Rules:

- Games consist of one (1) 15 minute straight time period
- Each team is guaranteed 3 (three) games – top two teams at each level will play off
- *note – KL Festivals Committee has the right to adjust the above if divisions do not fill
- **THERE IS NO BODY CONTACT ALLOWED**
- CSA approved equipment **MUST** be worn at all times
- Mouth guards are **mandatory**

E. Rules of Play:

- Face-offs will be at the beginning of each game.
- If the puck leaves the playing surface, play will be awarded to the non-offending team.
- Possession will be awarded in either the neutral zone or their own end, whichever applies.
- **Icing** and **Off-Side** will **not** be called.
- The referee will blow the whistle when: a goal is scored, the goalie freezes the puck, a infraction has occurred and a penalty has been assessed.
- Penalties will cost the offending team one (1) negative point (e.g. if the team has 5 goals and a penalty is called against them, they now only have 4 goals).
- Tied games, after regulation time, in the Round Robin will be recorded as a tie.
- Teams should be ready to play at least 5 minutes before the scheduled game time.

F. Penalties

a) Penalties

- There is **no body** contact.
- Minor Hockey rules apply

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- Games that get out of hand will be stopped and scores recorded.

- b) Penalty Shots (Playoffs Only):
 - If the score is tied at the end of regulation time, penalty shots will occur. Three players will complete a penalty shot. If the score remains tied after three shooters the format becomes sudden death.
 - The order of shooters continues as indicated on the score-sheet during the sudden death format. No going to the top of the list.
 - Ex. 3 penalty shots taken during regulation. If sudden death is needed, player 4 will be the first to go.

- I. **Standings and Tie-Breakers:**
 - Points will be awarded to teams on the basis of: 2 (two) points awarded for a win, 1 (one) point awarded to each team for a tie. No points awarded for losses
 - During playoff games, penalty shots will be used to break ties. Teams will alternate taking penalty shots one per team, until the game has been decided
 - The shooting order must be handed in prior to the playoff game starting
 - Standings of teams tied with equal points at the end of Round Robin will be determined as follows:
 1. Number of wins
 2. Total number of goals scored through the tournament
 3. Fewest penalties overall.
 4. Coin Toss.
