Fishing Hours: 8am-2pm only (registration begins 7am)

Lake: Otto Lake (Culver Park)

Snowmobiles & ATV's: will be permitted on the lake at participant/driver's own risk

Reception: Northern College Gymnasium at 6 pm

Tickets: \$100 each (2 lines per ticket)

Ages: 19 years and over

Fish Derby Rules & Regulations:

- 1) Registration begins at 7am. Please bring photo ID & derby ticket stub to registration.
- 2) Only those participants who are officially registered and whose name appears on the ticket stub will be eligible for prizes.
- 3) Pickerel-Walleye Prizes (registered ticket holders only): 5 x \$1000 pickerel draws. Bring fish to ballot station on the ice and receive 1 ballot per live pickerel for live draws.
- 4) Pike Prizes (registered ticket holders only): 5 x \$1000 pike draws. Bring fish to ballot station on the ice and receive 1 ballot per live pickerel for live draws.
- 5) There are FIVE tagged fish worth \$5,000 each. Tag numbers posted at gate & ballot station.
- 6) When a participant catches a fish, they must bring their live fish and their ticket stub to the ballot station immediately (fish eligibility at derby official's discretion).
- 7) Participants must have their purchased ticket stub on their person during the competition. There is a maximum of 2 lines per person/ticket holder as per provincial laws.
- 8) The derby begins at 8 am and will be signaled by the blow of a horn. No fishing lines are permitted in the water until that time.
- 9) The derby ends at 2 pm and will be signaled by an additional blow of the horn.
- 10) Ticket-holders are permitted to bring One (1) participant in the free kids derby (18 yrs & under).
- 11) KL Festivals Directors & members of their immediate households are not eligible for fishing prizes.
- 12) Fish must be live & caught in accordance with provincial laws & these rules/regulations.
- 13) All registered ticket holders (19 yrs & older) are eligible for the \$5000 elimination draw at the reception/pub beginning at 6 pm on Sat Feb 24 in the Northern College Gymnasium followed by the Tragically Hip tribute Little Bones at 10 pm. Your fish derby ticket is required for admission.
- 14) Early Bird prizes: Saturday Dec 24th: \$1000, Friday Jan 5th: \$250, Friday Jan 19th: \$250, Friday Feb 2nd: \$250, and Friday Feb 16th: \$250.
- 15) Each registrant and participant agrees to release and hold harmless the Kirkland Lake Festivals Committee and its sponsors from any and all claims for damages or injuries arising during the 2018 Fish Derby and Elimination Draw.
